



ColourSpace Installation

Install ColourSpace via the supplied installer program, and when running use Help/License to enter your specific ColourSpace License Key.

Antivirus False Positives

ColourSpace is verified by Light Illusion to be virus free. Light Illusion additionally submits ColourSpace for independent testing via 3rd party AV security providers, specifically when any AV program generates a false positive.

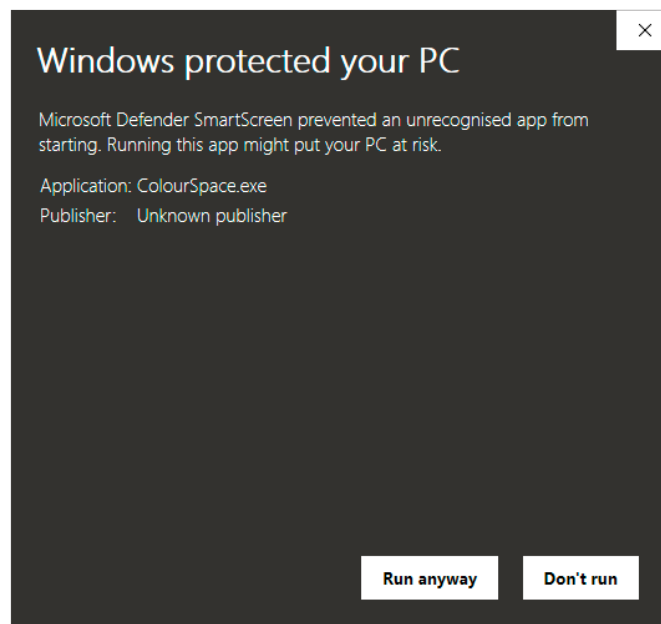
If a false positive is shown, please whitelist ColourSpace within your AV software, and inform the manufacturer of the specific AV program generating the incorrect virus detection of the issue.

Please also inform Light Illusion and we will also contact the AV provider to enable them to correctly assess ColourSpace.

Unrecognized App

When installing ColourSpace on a Windows PC, you may get a message stating: 'Windows Defender SmartScreen prevented an unrecognized app from starting. Running this app might put your PC at risk'.

Installing ColourSpace will not put your computer at risk. You can safely ignore any such *Protection* message and continue with installation via *More info* and *Run anyway*.



Windows Defender SmartScreen is used to alert when an app seems suspicious. With ColourSpace, this message is a false-positive, due to the relatively small number of ColourSpace installations.
